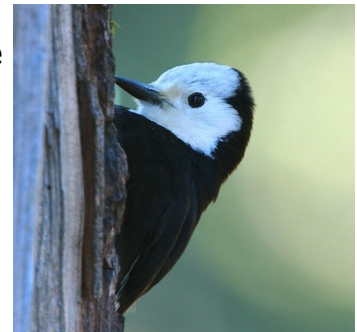

The Mountain Bird Festival combines a celebration of the region's spectacular mountain birds with the stewardship ethic needed to ensure thriving landscapes for humans and wildlife. Every citizen who participates in this festival will receive an attractive conservation stamp for acting as a significant steward of the science that drives bird conservation.

The Mountain Bird Festival offers guided bird walks, keynote presentations, fine art galleries, cocktail parties, music, local foods, and a feel-good community atmosphere. Mountain bird specialties of the region include Calliope Hummingbird, Mountain Quail, White-headed Woodpecker, and Great Gray Owl, among others. Come for the mountain birds, and also enjoy the region's many other attractions, such as local wineries and the Oregon Shakespeare Festival.
